



Champions for Sustainable Communities Awards

Judging Criteria:

The judges are looking to reward individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to the sustainability of communities. Please be as descriptive as possible as to why this person deserves a Champions award.

Nominees may contribute to sustainable development by:

- Contributing to the social, economic and environmental needs of their community in a joined-up way
- Meeting the needs of both existing and future generations
- Contributing to social cohesion and inclusion

For example, the nominee may have set up, managed, or supported a:

- Local food co-operative
- Community composting scheme
- Walking bus to the local school
- Community renewables project

Judges are looking for individuals that have clearly made a difference, without whom key initiatives might not have happened. They are keen to see a winner who has brought enthusiasm and leadership to sustainable communities, responded to a local community need and demonstrated how sustainable development can support and assist communities.

Notes:

- The awards are free to enter and open to all.
- Individuals can nominate more than one person for the awards but they cannot nominate themselves.
- Individuals can be nominated for more than one award category.
- Personal details will not be shared with any third party.
- After the closing date, the judges will review the nominations. This may require either the nominee or nominator to provide additional information.
- Winners must be willing to participate in the publicity attached to the awards.
